

# Early Puppy Reservation Agreement for Litter Due 2019

This agreement is between Serenity Anderson, "Breeder" and \_\_\_\_\_, "Buyer" to reserve the right to purchase one purebred Beagle puppy. No verbal agreements will be entered into.

The Breeder allows buyers to place a deposit before puppies are born or before Breeder is allowing buyers to select an individual puppy for reason of color selection, health or quality. This deposit places Buyer on a waiting list in the order Breeder receives deposits. The waiting list is a heirarchy that allows Buyer to select a puppy before subsequent buyers can purchase a puppy.

## Selecting a puppy

If submitting an early deposit before puppies arrive fill out this portion with any specifics you desire such as sex or color you're hoping to purchase.

If submitting an early deposit after puppies arrive but Breeder is not allowing selections yet, you can include the puppy's name you are most interested in.

If gender is unimportant you will be placed on both the male list and female list but will only be obligated to purchase one puppy.

## Costs and deposits

Total cost of each puppy in the **Early Reservation** program is \$400. This is a discounted price the Breeder gives because **Early Reservation** of a puppy means one less puppy the Breeder has to advertise. Any puppies not secured by the **Early Reservation** program will be \$450.

**Early Reservation** requires a deposit of \$100 paid by the Buyer to the Breeder upon or prior to submitting this agreement. The deposit is non-refundable in most cases. The balance of \$300 is due by pickup at 8 weeks of age. The final payment must be made in cash. Money orders and personal checks will only be accepted if balance is paid by 6 weeks of age, although pickup time is still 8 weeks of age.

## Current waiting list

This list is current at time this agreement was sent to Buyer. The list may change if another buyer is sending in a deposit simultaneously. Names are placed on the list in order deposits are received.

## Timeline and selecting a puppy

Once the deposit has been made and the puppies are born, the breeder will allow buyers to select their puppy in **order the list indicates beginning at 3 weeks of age**. All buyers will only have **24 hours** to select their puppy before Breeder allows the next Buyer to pick, allowing the entire list to be fulfilled by approximately 4 weeks of age. At this point, everyone will have received multiple pictures and info since the puppies' birth that could lead them to making their decision. If decisions cannot be made within 24 hours of notification by Breeder, the Buyer will get dropped one spot in the hierarchy for every 24 hours that passes.

**Selections can be made before 3 weeks of age** if the first pick buyers do not care about color (the blue tick and red tick puppies will look like traditional tri colors until around 3 weeks of age). If first pick buyers select their puppy early, Breeder will allow second pick buyers to select a puppy only if they are not concerned about color either and so forth down the list.

## Refunds and transferring selection

The **Early Reservation** program requires a \$100 deposit that is non-refundable unless specific instances occur.

### Reasons a deposit would be refunded:

- A. Buyer has first pick female (or male puppy) and there are no live puppies born of that gender. This will constitute a deposit refund and Buyer is no longer obligated to pay any money nor will Buyer receive a puppy.
- B. Buyer has selected a female (or male puppy) and the Breeder subsequently sells all the remaining puppies of that gender. Buyer's puppy dies for any reason while in Breeder's care. With all other puppies sold, Breeder cannot revoke reservation from another Buyer. This will result in a refund of Buyer's deposit and Buyer is no longer obligated to pay any money nor will Buyer receive a puppy.
- C. Buyer is on the female (or male puppy) waiting list, but there are not enough females in the litter to fulfill the reservations. A refund of the deposit would be made to the buyers too low in the hierarchy to select the gender of their choice.

### Reasons a deposit would not be refunded:

- A. Buyer has made a deposit but doesn't want to choose a puppy or doesn't like any puppies born to the litter. No refund would be granted and all puppies will be sold to other buyers.
- B. Buyer selects a puppy but later decides they do not want to follow through with the purchase for any reason. Any puppy not paid in full by 8 weeks of age will no longer be reserved for the Buyer and will become available to the public again unless other arrangements have been made with Breeder. No refund would be granted.

**If for any reason Buyer's selected puppy dies while in the care of the Breeder** and there are no other puppies available for sale of that gender, Buyer is permitted, but not required, to select a puppy of the other gender. Buyer's name will go to the top of the hierarchy to choose any of the **available** puppies. The deposit and this agreement would transfer to the latest puppy selection.

**If at any time Buyer has decided they prefer a different puppy rather than their selected puppy**, Buyer is permitted to transfer selection to any available puppy after the remaining waiting list has made their selections. This agreement and the deposit would transfer to the latest puppy selection.

**Breeder will never revoke a selected puppy from other buyers to fulfill the reservation in this agreement.**

## **Health and guarantees**

Breeder has made every effort to provide all buyers with a healthy puppy. Dewclaws will be removed by a veterinarian at birth. Nail trimmings, vaccinations and dewormings will be administered by Breeder at standard intervals. All puppies will be seen by a veterinarian around 8 weeks of age for a puppy wellness exam. Puppies can then go to their new homes around 8 weeks of age. Breeder administers the puppies' first vaccination at 6 weeks of age. Buyer is then responsible for any further care including the necessary 9 week and 12 week vaccinations to give the puppy full protection, and if recommended by Buyer's vet, a 16 week vaccination as well.

All puppies will sell with a health guarantee which requires an exam by your veterinarian within 3 business days of Buyer taking possession of the puppy. The health guarantee is further detailed in the final sales agreement.

**This contract is designed to protect both the breeder and the buyer.**
